## New Facilities Up and Running!

After a long slog and countless man hours put in by my father-in-law, Richard Hillier and an assortment of workers, our new barn, nicknamed "Silver Hills" after my family's Australian property, is working wonders. Built with using as many local and reclaimed materials as possible, the barn really seems to suit the horses. Not only does it house stabling for up to 18 horses, it also covers a Claydon Horsewalker, a washdown/ farrier/ veterinary area with warm water, a heated rug room and rest room for staff and liveries... It really has changed our lives and provided an extra dimension to the level of management of the horses.

The building works also provided us with the opportunity to enlarge and improve our lorry parking, gateways and fencing. We are lucky to have over 100 acres here and we have started to increase our use of the 50 acres the other side of Peasley Lane, which will be where we run our stud and produce horses for sale. Now, I'm dreaming of how to get my all weather gallops built!!!
